

## Nearly 1 in 3 El Paso crashes ends with a driver fleeing the scene.

Across 82,107 reported crashes in the City of El Paso over the last five years, **23,583 (28.7%)** involved a driver fleeing — roughly **2.5× the U.S. urban average** of ~11% (AAA Foundation). The share has held between 27.1% and 29.3% every year. Stability of that magnitude indicates a structural pattern, not a crime wave or fluke.

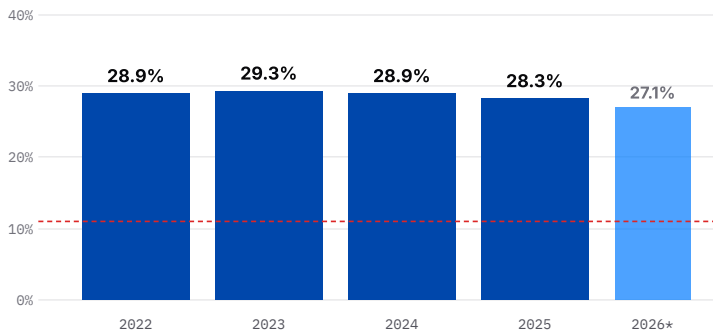

**Methodology.** Data: TxDOT CRIS public Query Builder, year-by-year exports for City = EL PASO, 2022–2026 YTD. Unit of analysis: 82,107 unique crashes after dedup on Crash ID. Hit-and-run = any unit with Vehicle Hit and Run Flag = Yes. Rate-based ranking restricted to intersections with ≥30 reported crashes over 5 years to avoid small-sample noise. National comparison ~11%: AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. Full data, code, and intersection list:
